RAMS OFFENSIVE NOTES

- With 284 passing yards on the day, QB **Jared Goff** now owns three of the Rams' top 11 single-season passing outputs:
 - No. 2 -- 2018, 4,688 yards
 - No. 10 -- 2019, 3,996 yards
 - No. 11 -- 2017, 3,804 yards
- After catching a TD pass in the 2nd quarter RB Todd Gurley II is now tied for 2nd-most receiving touchdowns by a running back in franchise history alongside Vitamin Smith and Lawrence McCutcheon with 12. Marshall Faulk leads all Rams running backs with 27.
- Following a rushing touchdown in the 4th quarter, Gurley II tied Steven Jackson and Eric Dickerson (56) for the secondmost rushing touchdowns in franchise history. He now trails only Marshall Faulk (58) for the most all-time.
- The rushing touchdown was Gurley II's 10th of the season, giving him four seasons (three-straight) with 10-plus rushing touchdowns in a season. He becomes just the second running back in franchise history to rush for double-digit touchdowns in three consecutive seasons, joining Dickerson, who did so in 1983-1986. Gurley II and Dickerson are also the only two running backs in Rams history to have four 10-plus rushing touchdown seasons.
- WR Cooper Kupp's 11-yard reception in the 3rd quarter pushed him over the 1,000-yard receiving mark this season, marking the first time in his career that he's accomplished the feat. Kupp became the third wide receiver under Head Coach Sean McVay to have 1,000 receiving yards in a season. WRs Brandin Cooks and Robert Woods did so in 2018.
- Sunday was another strong performance from TE Tyler Higbee, who became the first tight end in frachise history to have threeconsecutive 100-plus yard receiving games. Higbee is now the third tight end in franchise history to record three 100-plus yard games in their Rams career. He ended the day with a careerhigh 12 catches for 111 yards.

RAMS DEFENSIVE NOTES

- S Taylor Rapp posted 10 tackles on Sunday, yielding him double-digit totals for the third time this season. Rapp is the only rookie to accomplish the feat this season (through 4 p.m. kickoffs on Sunday).
- LB Cory Littleton finished the day with 12 tackles (four solo), giving him double-digit tackles in six games this season. Littleton now has 124 tackles on the season, two shy of a career-high.
- Rams DT Aaron Donald added another tackle-for-loss to his arsenal, bringing him to 19 on the season. Donald led the league in the category entering Sunday's game.



- Thomas also recorded his first special teams tackle of the season in Sunday's contest.
- **Hekker's** 67-yard punt in the third quarter tied for his second-longest punt of the season (Week 11 vs. Chicago). His longest punt of the year came in Week 1 at Carolina (68 yards).
- WR **Cooper Kupp** caught a touchdown in the fourth quarter, his eighth of the season. The total continues to build on a career-high for Kupp, who surpassed his previous high of six receiving touchdowns in L.A.'s Week 14 win over Seattle.
- CB **Darious Williams** finished the game with a career high five tackles (four solo), including a tackle for loss. Sunday marked Williams' his first statistics recorded since Week 11 vs. Chicago.
- WR **Brandin Cooks** caught his first reception since Week 12 vs. Arizona on a 14-yard catch from **Goff** in the opening series of the game.
- On the final play of the 1st quarter, WR **Josh Reynolds** recorded a 28-yard reception from **Goff**, which tied his careerlong. The reception marked the sixth game this season he's notched a reception of at least 20 yards.
- LB **Travin Howard** finished the game with one pass defensed, giving him a pass defensed in consecutive games for the first time in his career.
- TE Johnny Mundt caught a career-high two passes for 15 yards in the game.
