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Rams Offensive Notes

- OL **Andrew Whitworth** started his 215th career game (219th game played).
- WR **Josh Reynolds** started his 15th career game.
- **QB Jared Goff** completed 25-of-32 passes for 200 yards and 1 TD. His 103.1 QBR hits a third consecutive-game this season with a passer rating above 100.0.
- **Goff** utilized the depth of the Rams receivers, spreading the ball around to five different receivers accounting for 22 of his 25 completions.
- On the opening offensive drive, TE **Gerald Everett** rushed for his first career touchdown and became only the third tight end to rush for a touchdown in Rams history.
- WR **Cooper Kupp** caught a strike down the middle from **Goff** with 7:02 left in the game and turned it in to a 55-yard touchdown. The score marks Kupp's fourth-longest scoring reception of his career. Kupp finished the game with five receptions for 69 yards.

Rams Defensive Notes

- DL **Michael Brockers** started his 125th career game and recorded his second sack of the season with two additional hits on Giants QB Daniel Jones. Brockers finished the game with two solo tackles
- OLB **Ogbonnia Okoronkwo** recorded his first sack of the season.
- DL **Morgan Fox** recorded his second-consecutive game with at least 1.0 sack in the game. He sacked Jones for an 11 yard-loss. Fox also tallied one TFL and forced one fumble (third of his career).
- LB **Justin Hollins** recorded his first sack as a Ram.
- DL **Aaron Donald** and OLB **Samson Ebukam** levied 0.5 sacks each on the day. Donald now has 75.5 career sacks, while Ebukam reached 10.0 sacks in his career.
- With 52 seconds left in the game, **CB Darious Williams** nabbed his second interception of the season, picking off Giants QB Daniel Jones on the 15-yard line to close out the game. The pick marks 4th of his career and matches a season-high of two interceptions.

Rams Team Notes



- The Rams held New York to only 295 total yards of offense, while limiting Giants QB Daniel Jones to only 195 passing yards on the day, the fifth lowest output as a starter.
- The Rams defensive unit matched a season-high 5.0 sacks. It is the second consecutive-game to reach 4.0 or more sacks this season.
- L.A. recorded eight tackles for loss, a season high and the most since Week 10 in 2019 (nine).
- Four of the Rams eight tackles for loss came by way of the Rams secondary - S John Johnson III (two), CB Jalen Ramsey (one), CB Troy Hill (one).
