Rams Team Notes

- The Rams' second Wild Card victory against Seattle since the 2004 season has earned the team a second appearance in the Divisional Round since Head Coach **Sean McVay** joined in 2017.
- The win marked McVay's third-career postseason victory.
- QB **John Wolford** became the fourth undrafted quarterback to start a playoff game under center for the Rams since 1950.
- **Wolford** left the game due to injury in the first quarter after completing three-of-six passes for 29 yards.
- QB **Jared Goff** relieved Wolford and ended the day completing nine-of-19 passes for 155 yards, one touchdown and a 93.1 passer rating. Goff's 15-yard touchdown strike to WR **Robert Woods** with 4:46 remaining in the game sealed the Wild Card victory.
- RB **Cam Akers** rushed 28 times for 131 yards, one touchdown and hauled in two receptions for 45 yards, totaling 176 yards of scrimmage.
- **Akers'** 176 scrimmage yards are the most by a rookie in their postseason debut in the NFL since 1970.
- **Akers** is the only Rams rookie to ever rush for 100-plus yards in a postseason game in franchise history.
- Of the 184 yards receiving, the ball was spread across five receivers with three receivers finishing with at least 45 yards receiving.
- WR **Cooper Kupp** finished with four receptions for a team-best 78 yards, including a 44-yard long.
- WR **Robert Woods** hauled in four receptions for 48 yards and one touchdown, including a 20-yard long.
- K **Matt Gay** connected on all three field goal attempts (36, 39, 40) and three extra points, totaling 12 points.

Rams Defensive Notes



- Defensively, the Rams unit held Seattle to 278 total yards of offense, the third-lowest Seattle has generated in a postseason game since drafting QB **Russell Wilson** in 2012.
- L.A. sacked Wilson 5.0 times. The 5.0 sacks are tied for the second-most in a playoff game and the most levied on a playoff opponent in 21 years. (7.0 sacks against Dallas, 12/23/1973)
- DL **Aaron Donald** posted 2.0 sacks, his first multi-sack playoff game. Donald now has 2.5 career postseason sacks. **Donald** ended the night with three tackles, two TFL and three hits on the quarterback.
- CB **Darious Williams** intercepted a Wilson screen pass intended for WR DK Metcalf and returned it 42 yards for a touchdown. It's the third-longest interception returned for a touchdown in Rams postseason history.
- The pick-six is the first defensive touchdown for the Rams in the postseason since the 2002 Divisional Round against Green Bay.
- OLB **Leonard Floyd** recorded 2.0 sacks, marking his third-consecutive game against Seattle with at least 2.0 sacks.
- DL **Morgan Fox** posted three tackles and 1.0 sack.
- S **Jordan Fuller** and ILB **Troy Reeder** led the defensive tackling effort, each recording seven total tackles. Reeder also hit the quarterback once.
