Rams Team Notes



- With the win at Washington, the Rams swept the NFC East, marking the first time Head Coach Sean McVay has swept the NFC East and the fourth time he has swept a division since 2017 (AFC South - 2017, NFC West - 2018, AFC West - 2018 and NFC East - 2020).
- The Rams had previously never swept the NFC East, even dating back to 1970 when the division first formed. The Rams have had seasons where they were undefeated against the NFC East, but no seasons where they beat every team in the division.
- The Rams scored a touchdown on their opening offensive drive, marking the fourth time in five games L.A. has scored a touchdown in its first possession.
- DL **Aaron Donald** (4.0 sacks) and LB **Troy Reeder** (3.0 sacks) became the first duo to players each record 3.0 sacks in an NFL game since Texans duo of Whitney Mercilus (3.5) & J.J. Watt (3.0) did it on 1/3/2016 vs. Jacksonville Jaguars (Week 17 of the 2015 season). The last Rams duo to each record 3.0 sacks was DEs **Robert Quinn** (3.0) and **Chris Long** (3.0) in a 2013 Week 8 loss vs. Seattle.



Rams Offensive Notes



- QB **Jared Goff** completed 21-of-30 passes for 309 yards, 3 TD (one rushing TD) and one interception with a 111.7 passer rating. His 309 passing yards marks his 21st game throwing for 300-plus yards. The 21 300-plus yard games ranks third in franchise history.
- With **Goff** completing seven-of-seven passing attempts on the opening offensive drive, he has now completed 20-of-21 (95-percent) of his opening drive passes this season (Per ESPN Stats and Info.).
- **Goff's** 111.7 passer rating is his fourth-consecutive game with 100-plus passer rating.
- The 56-yard touchdown strike to WR **Robert Woods** was Woods' 30th career scrimmage touchdown and the second-longest receiving touchdown of his career. Woods finished with 71 yards on four receptions.
- RB **Darrell Henderson Jr.** recorded two touchdowns from scrimmage, one rushing and an 11-yard receiving touchdown. It is the first receiving touchdown of his career and the first multi-touchdown game of his career. He ended the day with 15 carries for 38 yards on the ground.
- WR **Cooper Kupp** hauled in five receptions for 66 yards (13.2 average) with a 49 yard long reception.
- TE **Gerald Everett** finished with 90 yards on four receptions. The 90 yards is Everett's third-highest single game total of his career.
- RB **Cam Akers** rushed nine times for 61 yards, including a 46-yard burst to mark the longest rush of his career.

Rams Defensive Notes



- The Rams defense levied 8.0 sacks, tying for the most in the league this season for single-game sacks.
- DL **Aaron Donald** matched a career-high 4.0 sacks, the fifth time in his career to record 3.0-plus sacks in a game, his second multi-sack game of the season and the 21st multi-sack game all-time.
- LB **Troy Reeder** recorded 3.0 sacks, with his first career sack taking down Washington QB Kyle Allen in the first quarter.
- **Reeder** tallied 10 total tackles (seven solo), two TFL and three hits on the quarterback.
- OLB **Jachai Polite** recorded 1.0 sack, the first of his career.
- OLB **Leonard Floyd** tallied two tackles, one QB hit and one TFL.
- DL **Michael Brockers** tallied six tackles.
- S **John Johnson III** tallied four solo tackles (five total) and one pass defended.
