Rams Offensive Notes

- RB **Darrell Henderson Jr.** started the first game of his career.
- **Henderson Jr.** rushed for 114 yards on 20 carries (5.7 yards/rush) and one TD, reaching 100-yards in a single game for the first time of his career.
- QB **Jared Goff** went 23/32 for 321 yards (110.8 passer rating). It marked his 20th 300-plus yard passing game, matching Jim Everett for third in franchise history for total games throwing 300-plus yards.
- **Goff's** 1-yard rushing TD marks his first of the season and the seventh rushing touchdown of his career.
- TE **Gerald Everett's** 34 yards on two receptions puts him over the 1000-yard mark in his career (1,013 receiving yards). **Everett** becomes the 14th Ram's tight end to reach the mark.
- WR **Robert Woods** scored on a quick-out where he ran 25 yards for a touchdown, the 26th receiving TD of **Woods'** career. He finished with 74 yards receiving.
- **Woods** also tallied 30 yards on three rushing attempts. The former Bill totaled 104 scrimmage yards in the game.
- WR **Cooper Kupp** hauled in nine receptions for 107 yards on the day.

Rams Defensive Notes

- The Rams defensive unit held Buffalo to 375 total net yards of offense, the lowest the Bills have generated all season.
- The Rams forced two takeaways, the second-consecutive multi-takeaway game of the season. The defense has now forced 12 total takeaways in the past five regular season games (2019-20).
- S **John Johnson III** picked off Bills QB Josh Allen with 4:13 left in the third quarter, posting his first interception of the season and eighth of his career. **Johnson III** ended the day with seven total tackles (five solo) and one pass defended.
- DL **Aaron Donald** posted 2.0 sacks, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery. It marks Donald's 16th-career forced fumble.
- OLB **Leonard Floyd** and DL **Morgan Fox** each added 1.0 sack to give the Rams 4.0 total on the day.
- CB **Troy Hill** tallied a team-high eight total tackles (five solo).

- P **Johnny Hekker** played his 131st game, it was his first-career game without attempting a single punt.
