Rams Team Notes



- QB **Jared Goff** finished the game completing 24-of-43 passes for 234 yards and one interception and a passer rating of 61.6.
- **Goff** also matched a career-high seven rushing attempts for 23 yards (7-yard long).
- **Goff** completed passes six different receivers. WRs **Cooper Kupp** and **Josh Reynolds** finished with 66 and 65 yards, respectively.
- **Reynolds** had the Rams longest reception, a 26-yarder in the fourth quarter.
- **Kupp** hauled in five third-down-converting receptions in the game. Kupp has 76 total third-down-converting receptions in his career. Kupp's 76 third-down conversions are the third-most by a Rams receiver since 1991 and ties for sixth-most through a player's first four seasons in the league since 1991.
- TE **Tyler Higbee** hauled in three receptions for 34 yards and averaged 11.3 yards per reception.
- RB **Darrell Henderson Jr.** rushed 12 times for 62 yards, including a 23-yard long.
- Defensively, the Rams sacked Seahawks QB Russell Wilson 5.0 times. It marks the fifth game this season with at least 5.0 sacks.
- L.A.'s defense forced a three-and-out on the Seahawks' opening drive. It was the sixth three-and-out on an opponents' opening drive, which is the third-most in the league this season.
- L.A. allowed 95 rushing yards, the seventh game this season the Rams have held their opponent to 100 yards rushing.
- OLB **Leonard Floyd** posted seven tackles and 2.0 sacks resulting in 11-sack yards.
- **Floyd** has totaled 5.0 sacks on Seahawks QB Russell Wilson this season, it's the most Wilson has endured by one player in a single season of his career.
- DL **Sebastian Joseph-Day** posted the first sack of
